**Date of event:** 17th September 2025

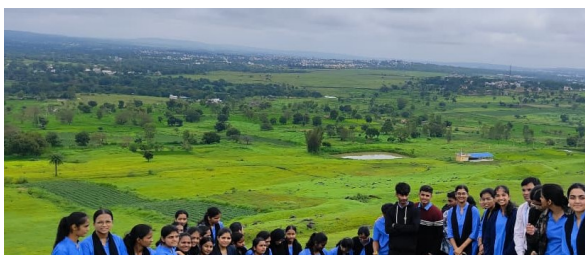

**Highlights of the Event :**

A field visit was organized for the B.Sc. I Year Zoology students to study, collect microorganisms for protozoan culture. A total of 36 students, accompanied by two faculty members, Dr Basavaraj B. Goundadkar and Mrs. Mansi sawant participated in this educational activity. The students visited Mandoli, Belgavi, where they explored the diversity of aquatic life. The Students reached the site at 8:00 a.m., through the college bus and actively engaged in observing and identifying the rich variety of organisms present in the natural habitat. The primary objective was to collect water samples for observation under microscope and establishment of protozoan cultures in the laboratory. Students collected different water samples from varied microhabitats at the site. These samples were carefully labeled and brought back to the laboratory for further analysis. On examination, the students observed the movement under microscope and diversity of microorganisms. The visit provided the students with practical exposure to field-based collection techniques, biodiversity exploration, and sample handling procedures. It also enhanced their understanding of the importance of protozoa in aquatic ecosystems and their role in laboratory studies.
